**Frederick-Firestone Fire Protection District To Hold Election for Board Of Directos**

**FREDERICK, Colorado** – The Frederick-Firestone Fire Protection District will hold an election on Tuesday, May 8, 2018, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. At that time one director from Ward two (2), and one director from Ward three (3) will be elected to serve a four-year term each.

To qualify to serve on the Board of Directors you must be registered to vote in the State of Colorado, be a resident of the District or own taxable real or personal property (or be the spouse or civil union partner of someone who owns taxable real or personal property) within the District or a person who is obligated to pay taxes under a contract to purchase taxable property within the District, within the respective ward boundaries.

The Board holds regular meetings on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of every month at 7:00 p.m. The meetings are held at Frederick-Firestone Fire Protection District Business and Education Center, 8426 Kosmerl Place, Frederick, Colorado. Special meetings may be held as often as the needs of the District require. A Director is entitled to Director's fees in the amount of \$74.00 for each meeting attended, not to exceed \$1,200.00 in a calendar year. These meetings usually run between one and two hours.
