**Frederick-Firestone Fire Protection District
Responds to Residential Fire**

FIRESTONE, COLO. – On Tuesday, July 10, 2018, the Frederick-Firestone Fire Protection District responded to a residential structure fire alarm on Jackson Drive in Firestone. The 9-1-1 call came in at 3:43 p.m. and the fire was successfully extinguished by 4:04 p.m.

The two occupants of the home were not injured and are receiving help from the American Red Cross.

The Frederick-Firestone Fire District received mutual aid from its partners, Mountain View Fire Protection District and Platteville-Gilcrest Fire Protection District.

The cause of the fire is still under investigation.
